pegs (also known as rete

processes or rete ridges) are

the epithelial extensions

that project into the

underlying connective

tissue in both skin and

mucous membranes.. In the

epithelium of the mouth,

the attached gingiva exhibit

rete pegs, while the sulcular

and junctional epithelia do

not. Scar tissue lacks rete

pegs and scars tend to shear

off more easily than normal
